The Chicago people who are in Washington in the interest of an amendment to the World's Fair act of the last session of Congress, permitting the opening of the exposition on Sunday, have, to use a sporting expression, been "fought to a standstill," by the opponents of Sunday opening. The House committee having the matter in hand, of which Representative Duborrow, a Chicago man is Chairman, is almost urani mous in favor of Sunday opening, but opposition has shown itself in so many quarters that the matter will not be pushed just now. A number of Senators have expressed most positively their belief that it would be an impossibility to carry Sunday opening through the Senate, even if it gets through the House. Still shrewd management may do much in the confusion of the closing days of the session.

An effort will be made in the Legislature this winter to amend the ballot law by substituting the blanket ballot for the half dozon ballots, more less, that are used now No fault will be found with such a substitu tion. An effort will also be made to pass a law requiring personal regis tration throughons the State. This would be one of the most nonsensical measures that could be inflicted upon a suffering people. Its ostensible aim would be to prevent fraudulent voting, but its real effect would be to either disfranchise a great number of voters or put them to unnecessary trouble and expense in going before a registry board, located in many instances at a great distance from their homes. There is practically no fraudulent voting in the country, and every member of the Legislature who lives in a town with less than
