### Twenty Buildings Burned.

Last Friday twenty buildings were burned in the town of Galena, Md. The town has the same system of fire pro tection that Andover has. How foolish the people out there are!

Last Sunday night about 8 o'clock fire was discovered in Leavitt's livery stable in Wilton, Maine. There is no apparatus in the village to fight fire and the flames made sad havor with a ot of wooden buildings adjoining. It was 2 o'clock next morning before the fire was under control. From the livery stable the flames communicated with the Wilton Hotel stable and house and then extended both ways on the south side of Main street. Fourteen buildings are in ruins, including the Wilton three dwelling houses.
