

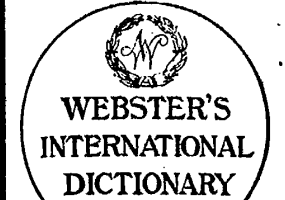

Twenty Buildings Burned.

Last Friday twenty buildings were burned in the town of Galena, Md. The town has the same system of fire protection that Andover has. How foolish the people out there are!

AND HERE, TOO!

Last Sunday night about 8 o'clock fire was discovered in Leavitt's livery stable in Wilton, Maine. There is no apparatus in the village to fight fire and the flames made sad havoc with a lot of wooden buildings adjoining it. It was 2 o'clock next morning before the fire was under control. From the livery stable the flames communicated with the Wilton Hotel stable and house and then extended both ways on the south side of Main street. Fourteen buildings are in ruins, including the Wilton Hotel, six stores, the post-office, the Wilton Record newspaper office and three dwelling houses.

Coal Mine Burning Forty Years.

Among the many valuable coal possessions of the Reading Co., none is richer than the three-mile stretch of land from New Castle on the east to Glen Carbon on the west. Unfortunately 40 years ago, while this land was being worked, fires originated at two different points and in two valuable veins.

Every means then known was taken to extinguish the flames, but without avail, and the fire is said to have already consumed several million dollars' worth of coal. Prior to and during the seventies, no less than three large collieries were in successful operation on these tracts, the Anchor, at Heckscherville, the East Pine Knot and West Pine Knot, at Greenbury and Coal Castle. Work had to be suspended and the collieries abandoned owing to the fire.

The Reading Co. have now determined to extinguish the flames if possible and borings are already being made to locate the present seat of the fire. When successful the surface will be stripped above the veins and the fire then confined to its limits and millions of tons of good coal thus saved. The managers are confident that with but little expense an immense area of the best coal in lower Schuylkill region can be saved and utilized to the profit of that corporation.
