The Woman's Christian Temperance Union of Andover meets the first and third Thursday in each month.

During one of the sessions of the International Typographical Union at Chicago last week a resolution to adopt a "sliding scale" with differing rates for men and women composers was rejected, the idea prevailing that equality of rates should obtain.

Kimball writes from Portland, Me., that already 172,000 autograph pledge cards have been ordered directly from her department, to be signed by the children and added to the collection of children's pledge autographs for the World's Fair.
