In reply the mayor said that he was "opposed to intoxication" as much as anybody but that he did not consider himself bound to do more than enforce the city ordinance providing for the closing of front doors and the drawing down of the blinds on Sunday. He was not obliged, he said, to enforce either state or national law. He particularly inquired how many of the eighty thousand signers were voters. This furnishes food for thought. Had every name of that petition been that of a voter would the answer have been the same, think you?

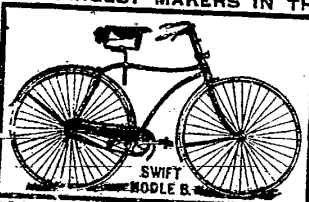

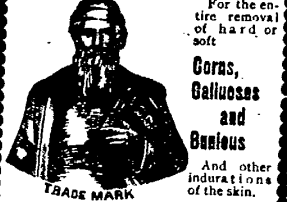
