Hon. John R. Mulvane, president of the Bank of Topeka, Kansas, speaks in unqualified praise of the effect of prohibition on the financial condition of his state. One great evidence of its prosperity he gives is that forty-four counties possessing poor-houses and farms are without a pauper, and in thirty-seven counties at the last term of the district court there was no criminal for trial.

President Harper says that when he was placed at the head of the Chicago University, he was strongly opposed to co-education, and entered upon his duties with the gravest misgiving because of the presence of the girls. He now declares that the only department of the University which has never made him the slightest trouble is the young woman's department.

A year ago, not less than forty-three total abstinence mayors were elected in England. Twenty of these were entertained recently by the lord mayor of London and gave their testimony to the benefits of total abstinence.

Dr. Bode, of Heidesheim, declares that the manufacture of intoxicating liquors in Germany rob the country yearly of four and one-half million of acres; it plunges thirty-two thousand into such poverty that they must be supported by the state or by friends; it sends four thousand two hundred and fifty into compulsory confinement in labor colonies; it has robbed thirty thousand of their reason and it has raised an army of criminals, one hundred and fifty thousand strong.
