The Woman's Christian Temperance Union of Andover meets the first and third Thursday in each month.

Iowa has extended suffrage to woman on property taxation. The bill passed the House, 51 to 39, and the Senate, 27 to 20. The friends of equal rights throughout the country will rejoice with the women of Iowa. Which will be the next State to join the procession?

The elections just passed in Colorado have shown conclusively that the women there want to vote. In a majority of the wards of Denver, more than half the votes cast were by women. The exceptions were in the low and degraded wards. There the woman vote was small. Though it was an unusually exciting election, good order was kept. The ladies were everywhere treated with courtesy, and all the voting places were adorned with flowers. The "filthy pool of politics" seemed to have given place to a garden. As the day progressed, it was apparent that the largest vote ever polled in the suburbs was to be recorded, the whole problem was lifted out of the realm of doubt, and many defeated candidates retired for the night satisfied that hereafter woman's influence at the polls must be given some consideration. As an evidence that women have not yet learned the wiles of the ward barnacle, it may be stated that they voted early and not one of them voted often.

The report from the spring election in Kansas and Colorado show four facts: First, a very large per cent. of women voted. Second, the "best women" in largest numbers. Third, the woman were divided in their party affiliations. Fourth, the woman vote was almost unanimous in the interest of law and order and good morals.

New York state has three thousand six hundred and seventy-five inmates of its juvenile reformatories, Kansas only two hundred and eight; New York eight thousand one hundred and ninety convicts in its penitentiaries, Kansas only nine hundred and eighteen. New York has twenty times as many paupers in its poor houses as Kansas.

The Des Moines, Ia., ministerial association has entered upon a campaign to oppose the return of the saloon under the mulct law, and will publish the name of saloon petitioners.

Christian Endeavor Notes.

The Y. P. S. C. E. of the Presbyterian church are paying for the support and education of a little Chinese girl in Peking, China. This is practical missionary work.

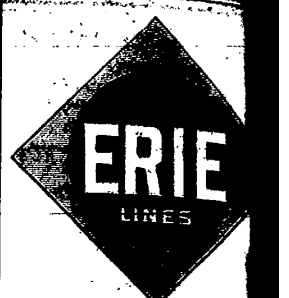
