From those baleful doors there issues nothing which tends to the uplifting of society, but rather to its downfall and disintegration.

This being the case, what is clearly the relation of citizenship to the saloon? There can be but one, and that is of absolute, unflinching hostility. By all that endears us to our homes and loved ones; by all that fires us with the flames of true patriotism; by all that inspires us with the hope of a nobler future, the citizen of this land and of this age should take his stand against that which is the greatest foe to his true citizenship.

Only the other day we heard a prominent prayer meeting habitude say: "A Christian man has no business in a primary meeting—no business at the ballot box!" And we could only pray God to forgive his narrowness and enlarge his view of Christianity. If there be one place more than another where the Christian man is needed today, it is in the primary meeting. If there is one spot more than another where Christianity should be highly concentrated, it is at the ballot box.

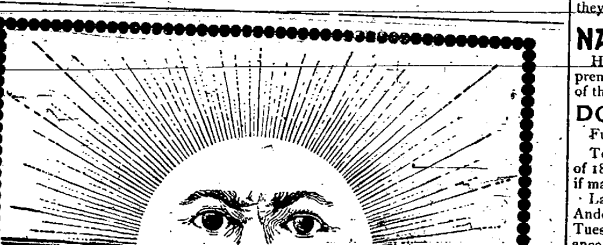
