The Woman's Christian Temperance Union of Andover meets the first and third Thursday in each month.

The district liquor dealers' convention held in Moline, is said to have spent three hours discussing the question, "What can we do with the meddlesome women?" The same convention passed a resolution declaring the W. C. T. U. more to be feared today than any other organization.

The citizens of Hornellsville are greatly dissatisfied with the recent action of the board of supervisors at a special session in Bath in which they voted to pay the long-contested bridge claims. Hornellsville regards it as unjustified in view of the recent decisions in the general term of the supreme court, and it is said that a taxpayer's action will soon be brought on to open the matter. The board stood 26 to 10 in favor of paying these claims and have already spent over \$1,000 litigating the question.


