If the drink traffic be "necessary" wiv debar the saloonkeeper from privileges enjoyed by men in other trades? Why class this perfeetly legal business with the illegal occupation of the professional gambler? We do not understand, though doubtless the "legal male mind" can explain; (1) why these societies should discriminate between the man who sells drink over the bar by the glass, and the man who sells it from the brewers or distillery by the barrel or the car load; and (2) why the man who keeps a saloon is any more detrimental to the interests of secret societies than the man who by perpetuating the saloon makes the saloon keeper necessary.
