

### W. C. T. U.

The Woman's Christian Temperance Union of Andover meets the first and third Thursday in each month.

To the noble Jew, Baron Hirsch, recently deceased, thousands of human beings are said to owe their opportunities for enlarged fields of usefulness. Although inheriting great wealth, he preferred a life of action and the luxury of doing good, irrespective of creed. His charities have been estimated at the enormous sum of ten million francs annually, his donation to South America in the colonization of Russian Jews in Argentina amounted to two million pounds. Christian and Jew alike mourn the passing of a brother to eternity.

The Massachusetts School Suffrage Association voted, April 29, to send a petition to the school committee of Boston, asking that in any effort to raise the salaries of teachers, the first consideration shall be to make compensation more equal by raising the salaries of women teachers.

All the bills for repeal of the strong temperance education law enacted in the New York legislature last year have been defeated, and the amendments which the friends desired passed the legislature with an overwhelming majority, just before the adjournment of that body. There is every reason to believe that the governor will sign the bill, and it will become a law.

The quantity of spirits, malt liquors and wines produced in the United States in 1894 is estimated at 3,000,000,000 gallons. In addition to this there were imported 10,000,000 gallons of malt liquors, brandy, wines, etc. The spirits, wines and malt liquors consumed in the United States during the year 1894 amounted to 1,200,000,000 gallons, an average of nearly eighteen gallons to every man, woman and child in the United States.

The "slum" population of New York-city numbers 360,000; Chicago, 162,000. The majority of the residents of the "slums" are Italians, followed in order of numbers by Irish, Germans, Austro-Hungarians, Russians and Poles. In the slum districts in New York city there is one saloon to every 129 persons; in the city at large one saloon to every 200 persons. In Chicago there is one saloon to every 127 in the slum districts; in the city at large one saloon to every 112 persons.

The sum of \$1,200 was withdrawn from the Batavia Loan Association in one evening, and every dollar of it went to pay for bicycles.

Canaseraga and Belfast will celebrate the Fourth. Angelica will concentrate her efforts on the Village Festival, occurring a week or two afterward.

The derrick for the Jasper and Canisteo Gas and Oil Company, located on Col. Bill's Creek, will be completed tomorrow (Thursday) and the drill is expected to be started tomorrow. —Canisteo Tidings.

There is some talk of a Fourth of July celebration in Almond. It is one hundred years ago this summer that this town was first settled and it is proposed to have a double celebration on July 4th.

The citizens of the villages of Hume and Fillmore, situated only one mile distant from each other, are agitating the advisability of consolidating the two school districts and erecting a suitable building half way between the two villages for a union free graded school.

The Hornellsville base ball club is considering the proposition of engaging Amos Rasie, the great New York pitcher, who is out of occupation over a misunderstanding. The Hornellsville people want him for three games, two of which will probably be on the Fourth of July.

H. T. Haines has been shipping several car loads of potatoes of late, paying 7 cents. He thinks potatoes will bring a fair price this fall and offers to contract with farmers now for 10,000 or 50,000 bushels at 25 cents. Seven or eight years ago when as low in price as they are now, in the spring, they sold in the fall at 40 cents, and it may be so this season. —Aurora News.

Craig & Tutton's store at Bentley Creek, McKean county, was robbed of several thousand dollars last April. A few days ago, while walking through the principal street of the village, John Stirtan noticed a tin box under the board sidewalk. Inside the box were found the \$2,200 in school orders and \$800 in notes and checks—all the property stolen with the exception of the \$590 in cash. —Bolivar Branch.
