The House of Representatives has adopted the Corliss bill, which provides in substance, that it shall not be lawful for male aliens to be employed on the public works of the United States for wages and live in a foreign country. It is also unlawful for persons or corporations to employ such aliens. An exception is made of sailors or railroad servants passing RESOLUTE? through the United States. Severe penalties are provided for the violation of the act.


