National pride differs from personal pride in degree only. The reason for this hesitancy is that he does not wish to be taunted with the words that he has "backed down" or was "forced to give in." It is the same in national controversies.

In the Lusitania case the Germans do not wish to read in the headlines of American newspapers that "American diplomacy won," or that "America has compelled the Germans to give in" or such spread-eagle talk, and it is just such talk from our papers and spread-eagle statesmen that renders the work of the administration so hard in securing and maintaining our rights. It would be more reasonable upon the administration securing a right to gracefully accept it by our people rather than to follow up its concession by other nations by our taunts. We should praise right doing rather than boast that we can compel it.

There are many who would excuse the acts of hyphenated Americans on account of love for their fatherland or mother country and America has even been accused of favoring the Aentra Allies on account of our love for England, the Mother Country, but our love for her did not prevent our having two wars with her, the Revolutionary war and that of 1812, and it is hard to see where we are or can be justly accused of favoring her on the ground of consanguinity. It is evident that the desire to work up a sentiment on such grounds is instigated from the outside.

Every American should be a patriot before a partisan and should stand by our President in his efforts to place our common country in a position where it is free from attack.
