Now, therefore, notice is hereby given that in pursuance of the power vested in me by law, I shall on Monday, the 13th day of November, 1922, at 2 o'clock in the afternoon, at the Court House, in the Village of Belmont, New York, commence selling at public auction so much of the several and respective lots, tracts or parcels of land as shall be sufficient to pay all State, County, Highway, School or other taxes assessed thereon for the year 1921, and in some in-

stances for the year preceding that may then remain due on each thereof respectively, together with all the interest thereon and other charges which may have arisen or accrued, and shall sell and continue to sell, until the said sale shall be completed.

The purchasers at such sale shall pay the amount of their respective bids to the County Treasurer within 48 hours after the first day of the sale, and receive certificates describing the land or property purchased, the sum paid and the time when the purchase will be entitled to deed; and after the expiration of one year from the last day of such sale, they shall be entitled to receive conveyances of the lands or property purchased by them respectively unless some other person entitled therein, pursuant to law, shall have previously redeemed the same by paying to the County Treasurer for the use of the purchaser, his heirs or assigns the sum mentioned in the certificate with interest at the rate of 10 per cent. per annum from the date of such certificate, any any tax which the holder of such certificate shall have paid between the days of sale and redemption together with the share of the expense of the publication of notices to redeem the real estate sold for unpaid taxes as apportioned by the County Treasurer to the real estate so redeemed.
