HIGHLIGHTS ON STATE CROPS

From New York State Dept. Farms and Markets Sept. 1, 1925.

Madison County Peas Higher

Under limited supplies early this week the price of peas advanced on fancy quality. On Tuesday as high as \$4 per bushel was realized on the very finest, says the Department of Farms & Markets. Ordinary stock brought \$1.

Other Vegetables Slow

The demand for other vegetables has been generally slow and the market weak. Orange county red onions on Tuesday brought mostly \$1.50-2.25 per 100-pound bag and yellows brought \$2.50-2.75.

The market on beans and cucumbers was steady on Tuesday but the demand was only fair. Latest prices are: Green beans \$1.25-2 per bushel basket, wax \$1.17-75; cucumbers ranged from 50c-81 per bushel.

Cauliflower From Long Island

Receipts of Catskill Mountain cauliflower have been moderate during the week but supplies from Long Island are steadily increasing. The bulk of Tuesday's sales of Catskill Mountain cauliflower were made at from \$2.50-3 per crate. Long Island ranged from \$1.50-2.

Lettuce sold at very low prices at the end of last week but is now slightly higher. On Tuesday Western New York stock brought 25-75c per crate and Oswego county 50c-81 per fancy \$1.25.

Other Vegetables

Latest prices of other vegetables follow: Cabbage \$1.50-2 per 100 pounds; rough celery mostly \$1-2 per two-thirds crate; Orange county carrots 75c-81 per bushel; tomatoes 30-50c per 12-quart basket.

Apples and Pears

Fancy, large-sized apples are wanted but small and ordinary receive practically no attention. On Tuesday a 2 1/2 inch barreled stock brought \$3.50-5 and baskets \$1-2. Pears continue dull with No. 1 Clapp Favorite at \$2-2.25; Bartlett's range from \$1.50-2.50 for No. 1's.

Butter and Eggs Firm

The butter and egg markets have been firm during the past week with

prices higher, especially on the high grades. Latest prices are: Creamery salted, higher score 46-46 1/2, 92 score 45 1/2. Nearby henery white eggs closed at 55-57c for average extras, and 47-53c for extra firsts; nearby henery browns, fancy to extra fancy 42-49c. The best grade of gathered whites sold at from 43-52c. Cheese closed at 22 1/2c per pound for fresh average run flats.

Cattle and Poultry Steady

Country dressed calves and live poultry recently have been fairly steady. Choice calves sold on Tuesday at 21c per pound; common to good 12-20c; light weights 10-14c. Colored fowls sold on Tuesday at 28-30c per pound, leghorn fowls 24-26c. Colored and leghorn broilers brought 28c per pound.

Hay Closing Steady

The hay market closed steady on Tuesday. U. S. Timothy No. 1 sold at \$27-28 per ton; No. 2, \$24-26; No. 3, \$21-23; Sample \$12-18.

Dairy Products

Butter markets firmer during the week. Receipts lighter and moved without difficulty. Production apparently shrinking. Consumptive demand apparently lighter than last year, since storage holdings showing increases despite decreased production. Closing prices on 92 score butter: New York 45c; Chicago 43 1/2c; Phila. 46c; Boston 45c.

Grain

Grain future markets sharply lower for week due to considerable liquidation. Increasing movement of spring wheat with slow four demand and small export demand weakened cash wheat market. Mill demand good at the lower price level. Larger offerings of old corn as new crop makes favorable progress lowered corn prices nearly 10c during week. Commercial stocks were increased with demand moderate. Oats lower

with corn but demand more active. Stocks accumulating rapidly at terminal markets. Live Stock and Meats

Chicago hog prices ranged from 5c lower to 50c higher than a week ago, closing at \$13.60 for the top and \$11.25-13.25 for the bulk. Medium and good beef steers were 50c lower at \$6.75-14; butcher cows and heifers were to 35c lower at \$3.50-12.50; feeder steers 25c lower to 75c higher at \$6.25-8.50; light and medium weight veal calves 25c-50c lower at \$9.50-13. Fat lambs steady to 40c higher at \$13.25-15.40 feeding lambs weak to 50c lower at \$13.50-15.50; yearlings steady at \$9.25-12.25 and fat ewes steady at \$4.50-8.25. Stocker and feeder sheep from 12 important markets during the week ending August 21 were: Cattle and calves 71,527; hogs 7,029; sheep 88,074. In eastern wholesale fresh meat markets beef is steady to \$2 higher; veal \$1 lower to \$2 higher; lamb \$4.5 higher; mutton \$1-2 higher and pork loins steady to \$2 higher. August 31 prices good grade meats: Beef \$16-21; veal \$16-20; lamb \$25-28; mutton \$12-16; light pork loins \$27-34; heavy loins \$12-24.

Fruit and Vegetables

Potatoes tend downward in eastern markets, nearly steady in mid-west. New Jersey sacked Irish 23.5c-26.5c per hundred pounds in eastern cities; \$2.15-2.35 f.o.b., central and northern New Jersey sacked early Ohio ranged \$2.2-2.10 in Chicago market. Sweet potatoes steadily. East shore Virginia veal varieties ranged \$4.25-5.50 per barrel in leading markets which is on a level with a week ago. Tennessee Nancy Halls brought \$1.75-2 per bushel
