"ARGENTINE LOVE"

At the Auditorium, Friday and Saturday Evenings, Sept. 25-26.

Juan Martin, a wealthy and powerful owner of vineyards in the Argentine, in return for financial assistance to Emanuel Garcia, mayor of the little old-world town of Alcorca, has promised this executive's daughter's hand in marriage.

The girl, Consuelo, has just returned from the states, following the completion of her education. In addition to absorbing modern ideas while at school, the girl has become engaged to Phillip Sears, an American engineer, who also arrives in the Argentine on the same boat, where he is to do construction work. The girl's aunt tries to break off the engagement, only to have Consuelo come out bluntly that she loves only Sears.

Juan Martin comes to claim his bride. The family points out that her education and even the clothes on her back have been paid for by him. Consuelo is furious, vows to take nothing more from Martin and leaves her protesting elders to live with La Mosca, her nurse, in a deserted hacienda that was once her father's old home. Martin sends a spy, Pedro, to watch the movements of the girl.

On the night of a great fiesta in town, Consuelo is induced to dance the tango with Juan Martin. She attracts the attention of Raphael, an ardent young Argentinian. In the presence of Martin, the girl encourages him. There is a quarrel between the two men and Raphael is killed. The townspeople vent their antagonism on Consuelo, whom they regard as the cause of the tragedy.

Following the murder, Senator Cornejo, father of the victim, and several high officials come to Alcorca to enforce justice. They find the townspeople and the Jefe (Consuelo's uncle) reluctant to prosecute the powerful Martin. A jealous rival of Consuelo turns the Senator and the people against her. The crowd attacks her, tie her to a cart and fog her. Phillip arrives in time to save her from the mob.

Later, when she has recovered, Consuelo is about to tell Philip of her love when Martin appears. Fearing for Phillip's life, she falsely confesses love for the other, who is now a fugitive from justice. He commands the girl to prepare to escape with him.

Believing he has lost Consuelo, Phillip tries to save her and Martin from the police by exchanging clothes with Martin. Martin and the girl escape on horseback, but at the home of the justice of the peace, Consuelo refuses to go thru with the marriage ceremony, confessing her love for Phillip. Martin leaves for the hacienda. The girl follows.

Not to be outdone in honor and sacrifice by Sears, Martin surrenders to the authorities. However, the vindictive Senator shoots Martin who with a final gesture, wishes happiness to Phillip and Consuelo.

"COMING THRU"

Tom Blackford is the chief clerk of a great steel corporation. He has just been promised promotion to the job of superintendent of mines, only to be cheated out of it time and again thru favoritism. There come to blows and Lawler falls—the sixty feet to a rock below.

Returning to his home, Blackford finds it empty and believes that Alice has returned to Pittsburg with her father. As he sinks down in a chair, disconsolate, a door opens and she enters.
