

The Voter About to Close the Curtain.

IMPORTANT TO VOTE IN SECRET, REMEMBER THIS

1. Pull a pointer or lever down towards the emblem and the name of the candidate you want to vote for

to vote for.

2. LEAVE all pointers or levers DOWN. Only the levers DOWN will be counted. (If you push them back you have NOT voted,—the voting machine will push them back as you swing the curtain handle to go out.) No one knows how you have voted when you leave the machine.

3. A lever must be left down for each candidate for whom you vote. If you null down the wrong the w

3. A lever must be left down for each candidate for whom you vote. If you pull down the wrong pointer or lever, push it back in place, pull down the correct pointer, and LEAVE IT DOWN.

DIRECTIONS IN DETAIL FOR VOTING ON THE VOTING MACHINE

Swing the Handle of the Curtain Lever (over-

head) from the Left hand side of the mac over to the Right as far as it will go, and lea there. (This will close the Curtain around and unlock the machine for voting.)

At the Left hand end of the machine (in col

1) you will find the names of all the candid

Then in Column 2 pull down the Pointer of the name of the candidate you wish to vote for Member of Assembly AND LEAVE IT DOW

Keep on in the same manner to the end of ticket, taking care to turn down a Pointer every office, AND LEAVE THEM DOWN.

After you have completed voting for all offices, look in the upper Left hand corner of machine and you will see the questions that to be voted on. Turn a Pointer towards the "Y

Leaving the Pointers DOWN in their voting p tion, swing the Handle of the Curtain Lever to Left as far it will go, and leave it there. (will register your vote and return the Pointer their first position, after which it will open Curtain.)

As no votes are registered until the Cu: Lever Handle is moved to open the Curtain can make as may changes in your ballot as wish while the Curtain Lever is at the Right.

The Machine is so arranged that you ca turn down more than the proper number of P ers for each office. Thus you can turn down pointer for one office, but no more.

In case the office is one to which two candi are to be elected, you can turn down any Pointers, even though one be directly under
