Small trees, plants and bulbs have been taken from the fields and woodlands in alarming numbers, some of which were successfully used to beautify private property, but the largest percentage, unfortunately, finally wound up in the family ash can or garbage collector's wagon.

The protection of America's wild flowers is a very important phase of nservation. Some states have already inaugurated laws which govern the picking of various species of plant life.
P. L. Ricker, President of the

Wild Flower Preservation Society, with headquarters at Washington, V. C., says: "It is generally thought that wild flowers can be protected legislation. However, birds and game are considered the property of the state while all plants are considered the personal property of the den to sell these plants no matter how rare, nor from delegating the violation of one, of the amendments to the Constitution, of the United States. 
