## "Black Magic" Practice

Her fame, of course, drew de Montespan, who along with a few minor episodes such as black mass celebrations, got embroiled in the famous "affaire des poisons," in which Montespan plotted with La Voisin to poison Louis XIV. The plot caused such a scandal that Louis closed the court. La Voisin was executed early in the case and de Montespan got off through influence. Later strangely enough, after she went into retirement, she became so good as to come near sainthood.
