

TWO SUGGESTIONS

FIRST: Read the Sample Ballot below carefully and decide which candidates you wish to vote for.

SECOND: Call the Town Clerk and find out where a voting machine is on public exhibition. Operate it until you are sure you can vote without trouble or delay. A few minutes spent will facilitate your use of the machine and may save time on Election Day.







Leave all Pointers DOWN. (If you push them back you have not voted. The voting machine will push them back as you swing the curtain handle to go out). No one knows how you have voted when you leave the machine.

As no votes are registered until you move the curtain lever to open the curtain, you can make as many changes as you wish in your vote while the Curtain Lever is at the Right side. If you pull down the wrong Pointer push it back in place, and pull down the correct one.

Likewise, in column 2, turn down the pointer over the name of the candidate for Lieutenant-Governor you wish to vote for, and leave it down. Keep on in the same manner to the end of the ticket, taking care to turn down a pointer for every office AND LEAVE THEM DOWN.

After arranging your ticket (leaving the pointers DOWN over the names of the candidates you wish to vote for) swing the handle of the Curtain
