3. Pitcher and catcher must not get out of their respective playing boxes, as will be faid lout on the field, -nor are they allowed to field a batted ball at any time.

4. Basemen are not allowed to block a base runner (that is if the umpire is looking.)

5. Infielders, if unable to catch the ball on the donkey, must ride to the location of the all, get off his donkey, pick up Ithe ball, and get back on his donkey before he throws If he fails to get on donkey before throwing it base runner is called safe.

6. Outfielders ride to the ball, if unable to field it from the donkey, he dismounts but holds to the reins. He has to mount his donkey before throwing the ball. Also outfielders are not allowed to make any play on the infield.

🗻 7. At any time a base runner loses his mule by turning loose of the reins, he is declared out.

8. A base runner is not allowed to get off his donkey in order to push, pull or carry his donkey to first base.

9. If base runner's donkey decides the grass is better at third base, instead of at first. base, runner is not out for running out of line if rider is trying to guide his donkey in the right direction—until of course ball is thrown to first base as

10. In touching the base runners, you do have to touch the rider, not donkey.

11. These rules will ordinarily cover most situations. However, there are times when the donkey force decisions that are not included in these rules, such plays are left up to the judgment of the umpire in charge.
