

Many people are wondering when we say John's Physical Fitness Index is 100.

When school opens in the fall and before it closes in the spring a group of tests are given. They are as follows:

(1) Lung capacity; (2) grip in both right and left hands; (3) [|back strength; (4) leg strength.|

These tests are computed in pounds. Then we have the stugirl's height and weight, we can determine to a certain degree a pupil's strength and large muscle cover all pupils whose ages range from 11 to 21 and whose weight is from 60 to 200 pounds, we can determine a normal strength manufacture of the Gray, Box 349, Andover.

For an example we will take a boy in seventh grade. He is 12 years old, weight 67 pounds; and 55 inches tall. His normal strength index (taken from chart) [/ is 575 points:
