

Grapes Aplenty

The New York State grape harvest this year promises to be a bountiful one. Most of the grapes are Concords, a slip-skin variety excellent for juice, jelly, butter, jam and table use.

If your sugar supply is low lnow, grape juice may be preserved without sugar and made into fresh jelly later; or the juice may be used as an appetizer, in punch, or as a base for fruit gelatin, salads and desserts.
