

Restriction of Gas For New Space Heating

EFFECTIVE APRIL 17, 1947, THE FOLLOWING RULE

RESTRICTING NEW GAS SPACE HEATING

HAS BEEN ADOPTED:

Until Nov. 1, 1947, no service will be supplied either to new customers or to additional equipment of existing customers for the heating of premises either by unit space heaters or by a central gas-fired building heating installation except

- (a) where a customer has a written agreement or memorandum in writing with the Company made prior to the effective date hereof for the purchase of space heating equipment, or
- (b) where a customer has contracted for the purchase of space heating equipment with an independent dealer and a request for space heating gas service at the customer's premises has been received by the Company from the contractor or the customer, as evidenced by Company records prior to the effective date hereof, or
- (c) where space heating equipment is to supply a building constructed or being constructed on the effective date hereof. for which gas-fired space heating equipment was provided in the building specifications on or before the effective date hereof, where said building has no adequate facilities for space heating other than by gas.
- (d) where, because of special or unusual conditions or circumstances, the above restriction will endanger life or result in serious impairment to health if space gas heating service is not rendered, and satisfactory proof thereof has been filed with the Company.

When the facts establish with reasonable certainty that a customer has connected additional building heating equipment after the effective date hereof and does not qualify under exceptions (a), (b), (c) or (d) above, the Company will discontinue service upon such notice as is or may be required by law until the additional building heating equipment has been disconnected.
