County Health Department?

It is a plan to improve the health of the citizens thru establishing a modern health department to control disease, improve [sanitation, and assure continued hospital facilities.

Who provides health service in the county at the present time? Each village and town in the county now has its own health district, administered by parttime health officers. Services are also provided by county nurses and the county-laboratory. & Under general supervision of the State District Health Office in Hornell, the county is provided limited milk, water and food in-


It sets up a single local agency that does away with duplication and over-lapping services: It is staffed by trained, full-time workers rather than part-time per-






