Miss Connie Lewis will be honored by several of her friends at a teen-age birthday party at the home of her parents, Mr. and Mrs. Francis Gavin of Barney St. Friday evening. Connie will be thirteen years old on Sunday, January 27th.

The old Bethesda Hospital building in North Hornell, vacant since construction of a new hospital in 1960, is being razed and may eventually be the site for new homes. After demolition work is completed the land on which the old hospital stood will be graded and divided into lots which the hospital hopes to sell for private building purposes.

An intensive search is underway in the village of Friendship for a phantom poisoner, who Tuesday claimed his sixth canine victim. Pet owners have been requested to keep them indoors, watching them at all times if permitted outside. Citizens are reported having become "uneasy" with several of them forming a "vigilante" committee to investigate neighborhood yards and garbage pails for a clue to the poisonings.

Miss Ella Rock, believed to be this county's oldest resident died Sunday evening in the Allegany County Home at Angelica. She was 103. A lifelong resident of the Belfast area, Miss Rock remained active until she suffered a fractured hip on St. Patrick's Day 1958. She had been a patient at the county infirmary since August of that year.

Hugh D. Chamberlain of Canadea, chairman of the Allegany County Soil Conservation District says that films from the film Library at the Belmont office have been shown to eighty groups interested in conservation in Allegany County.
