The Conservation Department reports 3,355 deer taken in Allegany County during the 1962 deer season. Steuben County had 3,382. Sullivan County was the leader with 4,894. The total deer take in the state was reported at 62,782 with 739 bagged with bow and arrow.

A card from Mr. and Mrs. Edward Kent of Eustis, Fla., mailed March 5th states that it had been cold there but warmer weather was with them, 80 degrees as of that date. They plan to be home in Andover in a couple of weeks.

A gingerbread contest and a Future Farmers of America speaking contest were held during

Wolfer will represent the county in the sectional FFA speaking contest to be held at Naples in April.
