Bids will be received by Glenora Pelton, Town Clerk, Andover, N. Y., until Thursday, April 4th, 1963, at 7:30 P. M., Eastern Standard Time, at which time the said sealed bids will be opened and read at the regular meeting of the Town Board held at the Town Hall in the Village of Andover, Allegany County, New York. Said used Roller shall be a 3-wheel type, 10 to 12 ton, variable weight, with hydraulic steering. Rear rolls shall be 20 inches in width, and front steering roll shall be 44 inches in width, with provision for front and rear rolling paths to overlap. Scrapers shall be provided for the rolls. Roller shall be a 1955 model or later and shall be equipped with a Hercules, 6 cylinder, gasoline engine. Bid price shall include delivery to the Town of Andover, New York. The Town Board and the Town Highway Superintendent shall be the sole judge of the acceptability of any equipment offered by bidders and of its conformity with the above specifications.
