### State University Admissions Examination To Be Conducted May 4th

A State University Admissions Examination will be conducted May 4 on the campus of the colleges listed below which are members of the University's uniform admissions program.

The examination is open to students who plan to apply to one of the colleges for the 1963-64 school year and who did not take the Regents Scholarship Examination in October. Students who took the Regents test will use the mark attained in that examination in applying to one or more of the colleges.

To be eligible for the May 4 examination, students must have completed applications for admission in the mail and postmarked no later than April 15. Application forms and complete instructions may be obtained by writing directly to the Office of Admissions of the college in which the student is interested.

University Centers and Colleges participating in the examinations: State University—at Albany; State University at Buffalo; State University at Stony Brook, L. I.

State University Colleges at Brockport, Buffalo, Cortland, Fredonia, Geneseo, New Platz, Oneonta, Oswego, Plattsburgh and Potsdam.

Harpur College, Binghamton; College of Forestry, Syracuse; and Maritime College, Fort Schuyler, New York City.

Agricultural and Technical Institutes at Alfred, Canton, Cobleskill, Delhi, Farmingdale and Morrisville.

The examination is not required of students who plan to enroll in the State University College of Ceramics at Alfred University, the four State University Colleges at Cornell University (Agriculture, Home Economics, Veterinary, and School of Industrial and Labor Relations), and the community colleges other than those listed above.

The admissions examination will also be administered July 22. However, students are urged to submit their applications as early as possible.
