News Briefs Of Local Servicemen

A Andover Central High School graduate, class of 1961 has recently been assigned to a modern cargo vessel of the American Merchant Marine. Cadet Kenneth Heselton, son of Mr. and Mrs. Richard Reselton of Andover, is now serving aboard the S. S. Pioneer Myth, operated by United States Lines in the equivalent capacity of a Junior Officer.

This vessel will call at the ports of Hong Kong, Manila, Tokyo, Keelung Pusan, Kobe, Yokohama, and Nagoya.

Upon departing from the Academy at the completion of their Plebe Year, Cadets are given a Sea Project to be completed during the Sea Year. The Project consists of a number of professional reports on electrical engineering, naval architecture and steam engineering, accompanied by detailed drawings supplementing these reports. The Project requires a considerable amount of time but will, in conjunction with practical operation of the vessel's

power plant, enable the Cadet to obtain a thorough understanding of the principles involved in marine engineering and their ship-board application.

Cadet Heselton will be graduated in July of 1965.


