One Truck with Utility Body and equipped as follows; Telescopic Boom, pedestal mount, with 36 ft. minimum height from ground to bucket floor; extension—a minimum of 11 ft. 6 in.; upper boom to be one piece laminated Fibre Glass; molded Fibre Glass bucket 24 in. x 26 in. x 42 in.; minimum wall thickness 3/16 in. with Master Hydraulic Control valve; ground controls to be full hydraulic in pedestal; key operated bucket tipping control in truck cab; automatic throttle emergency power; Mico brake lock; boom rest: torsion bar assembly.

A Hot Flame from a mixture of oxygen and nitrogen is necessary to make some glass soft enough to be shaped by a glass blower, reports Chemetron Corporation, which supplies gases to this small but vital industry. Hardest is quartz, with a melting point of 3,400 degree F., and softest is lead glass, which will turn molten at 600 degrees. Glass blowing is a key to production of custom-made laboratory ware, from simple pipettes to complex pumps.

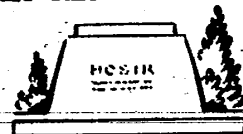
