Desalted Sea Water, a potential answer to increasing consumption in the U. S., is being drunk by residents of St. Petersburg, Fla., where a conversion plant in Tampa Bay is turning out 40,000 gallons a day. Indications are that the plant is producing each 1,000 gallons for about 60 cents, a higher cost than hoped for but still lower than the price being paid by many cities for piped-in fresh water. The U. S., which consumed 40 billion gallons of water a day in 1900, now uses 325 billion and will probably use 500 billion a day by 1950.
