**Chauffeurs License Expire May 31st**

Albany, May 10—If you are one of the some 412,000 New York State-licensed chauffeurs whose license expires May 31, and you have not renewed it yet, next week is the last you can do it by mail.

At least 10 days are required for both the postman and the offices of the Department of Motor Vehicles to complete the process and get your new license back into your hands on time. Thus, allowing for Saturdays, Sundays and the holiday of May 30, now is the time to get your renewal mailed to your nearest Motor Vehicle Office—either your County Clerk's office or one of the Department's district offices.

You do not have to use the mails, however. You can go to any Motor Vehicle Office, but in either case make certain that you have all the necessary documents in the envelope or with you when you call.

If you mail the application, be sure all questions are answered, that you sign in the required places and enclose the correct fee as shown, plus the renewal stub from your present license. You should take the same material with you if you stop at an office.

All chauffeurs eligible to renew should have received their new punch card applications by now. If you haven't or have lost it, you should go immediately to the nearest Motor Vehicle Office and make arrangements to obtain an application.

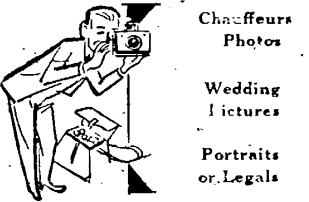
