



**Princeton Choir To Present Concert At Presbyterian Church**

The Princeton Seminary Choir will present a service of sacred music in the Andover Presbyterian Church on Thursday, June 13th, at 7:00 p. m.

This Seminary Choir of eighteen male voices is now on its eighteenth annual summer tour, singing on the average of twice a day. They will appear in New York, Michigan, all of the New England States, Ontario, Quebec, New Brunswick, Prince Edward Isle, Nova Scotia and Newfoundland.

All members of the Princeton Seminary Choir are College Graduates who are now enrolled at Princeton Theological Seminary for at least 3 years of graduate study in preparation for the Christian Ministry, and are from a cross section of our country. Three foreign students are members of the choir; one from Egypt, one from Scotland, and one from Korea.

The musical portion of the program ranges from ancient plain-song through Palestrina, Lotti, Bach, Handel, Haydn, and Mendelssohn as well as contemporary composers.

The chorus is directed by David Hugh Jones, Mus. Doc., who is a charter member of the faculty of the Westminster Choir College. Mr. Jones was head of the organ and composition departments of that school for years as well as director of Music at Princeton since 1934. In addition to these duties he was also Editor of THE HYMNBOOK, a widely used Church Hymnal.

The concert will begin at 7:00 P. M., in the Andover Presbyterian Church with the public cordially invited to attend.
