NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the annual meeting of the inhabitants of Central School District No. 1 of Andover, Allegany County, qualified to vote at school meeting in said district will be held at the schoolhouse in said district on Tuesday, July 9, 1963 at 8:00 o'clock p. m. for the transaction of such business as is authorized by the Education Law.
