The New York State Liquor Authority has announced that on Primary Day, September 5, 1963, the sale of liquor, wine and beer for on premises consumption is prohibited throughout the State during the hours when the polls are one—3 n. m. to 10 n. m. in are open—3 p. m. to 10 p. m., in New York City and 12 noon to 9 new York City and 12 noon to 9 p. m. elsewhere in the State. A state-wide prohibition also prevails against the sale of liquor and wine for off-premises consumption during these hours.
