Abstract of Proposed Amendment Number Four
 The purpose and effect of this proposed amendment is to adopt a new Article IX of the Constitution, providing for effective local self-governments; a bill of rights for all counties, cities, towns and villages; intergovernmental cooperation by such local governments; empowering the Legislature to provide for the creation and organization of local governments; requiring the Legislature to enact a statute of local governments granting additional powers of local legislation and administration; providing that the Legislature may act by general law concerning the
