**Local Justices Attend Conference**

Hon. George Mickle and Hon. Harry Kemp, Justices of the Peace Town of Andover, attended the Justice Training Program conducted by the Judicial Conference of the State of New York at Buffalo Law School, Buffalo, N. Y., as a candidate for a certificate of completion.

Chapter 705 of the Laws of 1962 provides that all justices, not lawyers, selected on or after September 1, 1962, must receive and file such a certificate prior to performing judicial functions.

The program is presented by instructors selected from the law school area. All the instructors are public officials, law school professors, lawyers, or justices experienced in Justice Court Practice. The program is made up of lectures and demonstrations on such topics as Criminal Procedure, the Law of Arrest, Search and seizure, procedure in Family Court Matters, Motions, Appeals and Coram Nobis, the Law of Evidence, Civil Procedure; a Radar Demonstration, Civil and Criminal Trial Demonstrations.

The Judicial Conference is presenting the statewide training program at five law schools located in Buffalo, Syracuse, Ithaca, Albany and New York City.

There are about 300 trainees from all over the state enrolled at the five schools. Adding this figure to the number of trainees who have already completed the training gives a grand total of almost 1000 justices who have completed or are about to complete the training since it was first offered in November of 1962.

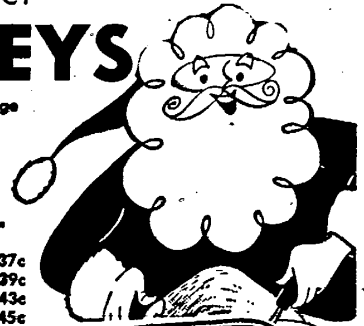
