Plans Available For Machinery Shed, Shop

Some farm operators might wish to build a machinery shed with adjoining shop, while others may prefer one adjoining living quarters. Plans for both are offered by the N. Y. State College of Agriculture, Cornell University.

The first design details a storage section of economical pole-type construction. It is erected in 12-foot units, so that it can be built to a size to meet individual needs. Concrete masonry is suggested for the walls of the shop,

which has a door 14 feet wide.

The second design provides a means of holding down initial building costs on new farms, according to the Cornell agricultural engineers. The living quarters may be converted to some other use when a permanent house is built.

The living section includes two bedrooms, a bath, kitchen, and living room.

The first plan (No. 5849) may be obtained for 50c, and the second plan (No. 5841) for 25c from county agricultural agents or by writing to Agricultural Engineering Dept., Riley-Robb Hall, Cornell University, Ithaca, N. Y.
