

Attention Motorists!

Albany, December 31 — When you attach your new 1964 New York State number plate to the rear of your car—which can be done after midnight tonight—what should you do with the blank space on front where ordinarily the second plate would go?

The Department of Motor Vehicle Commissioner William S. Hults points out, any sort of a device which resembles a registration plate may be declared illegal by a court, and you would then be charged with a violation.

Because the state is issuing only one plate for 1964, a number of gadget manufacturers are advertising novelty plates for sale for use on the fronts of cars. However, Commissioner Hults warned motorists that use of any such plate, which might resemble an actual registration plate, could possibly lead to the motorist's arrest.

Other motorists, who obtain the same registration number each year, have inquired about leaving their 1963 plate on the front, since the number would be the same as on the 1964 rear plate. This practice is clearly illegal, the Commissioner pointed out.

Incidentally, do not expect to receive a registration renewal application from the Department through the mail. Unlike driver license punch card renewal applications, you must obtain the registration blank from a motor vehicle office.

Owners of buses, school buses, ambulances and taxis must display their new plates by midnight tonight; dealers and transporters by midnight, January 10; commercial trucks and trailers by midnight, January 15. Passenger cars and motorcycles must display 1964 plates by midnight, January 31.

Agricultural Forecast For 1964

Allegany County farmers won't have much more money in their pockets in 1964 than they have had during the past year. That was the opinion expressed today by C. W. Hebblethwaite and Larry Davis County Agricultural Agents.

Population and income increases are expected to push the domestic demand for food to new heights. But the large supplies of farm commodities now available will temper any rise in farm prices, he said.

The agents are just back from a two-day economic conference on the Cornell University campus where Prof. Kenneth L. Robinson and C. Arthur Bratton, agricultural economists, did have one

bright note for the New York State picture. Slightly higher prices for milk, they said, will help to maintain the income of dairy farmers.

In the picture for 1964 the economists foresee record high exports, largely because of increased sales of wheat. U. S. storage holdings are expected to reach the lowest level in nearly 10 years.

The outlook for farm costs is not an encouraging one. Feed costs are already up and are expected to remain high this winter.

Looking at the long-range outlook for farming, Profs. Bratton and Robinson expect the number of farms to decrease, the size to increase and farm land values to continue upward. Machinery will take over more of the jobs done

by hired labor, buildings will be more efficient and farm families will need higher capital investments. All these developments point up the increasing importance of managerial skills, they said.

"Families with reasonable resources and management ability will adjust quickly and make a good living, despite the rapid rate of change, they concluded.
