Dog incenses for 1968 expired on December 31, 1963. The 1964 license fee is due January 1st. Licenses so issued will cover the period from January to December 31, 1964. Every dog must wear a tag of the current dog license year. A dog without such a tag is not protected by law and no action can be maintained for

a tag is not protected by law and no action can be maintained for his injury or destruction.

An unlicensed dog, must be seized and killed and the fact that a dog is without a tag is presumptive evidence that the dog is unlicensed.

License fees: Male Dog, \$2.25;
