Plan ACP Spring Practices Now

Farmers who have been considering soil-and-water-conservation practices tobe established on their farms with Agricultural Conservation Program cooperation next spring and summer should file their requests for program assistance as soon as possible, Farmers who have been conssistance as soon as possible, Stephen Clarke, Chairman, Agri-cultural Stablization and Conerva-tion Allegany County Committee, has suggested.

Under the 1964 program, cost-

share program assistance averages aboue half the cost of carrying out such conservation practices as establishing and improving vege-tative cover of grasses, le gumes, or trees for soil conservation or more efficient use of water.

In addition, the 1964 program provides for similar cost-share asprovides for similar cost-share as-sistance to farmers in developing soil-and-water-conservation prac-tices primarily for the benefit of wildlife. These include the es-tablishment of wildlife food plots or habitat, ponds and shallow water areas, and other practices which provide important wildlife conservation benefits.
