**Dairymen Can Choose Milk House Designs**

New York State dairymen who are planning to build new milk houses this spring have a choice of designs and building materials. Whether they plan to use wood or masonry block, designs for single or two-level houses are available from the N. Y. State College of Agriculture, Cornell University.  
 One of the wood-frame milk houses has a single four-inch-thick reinforced concrete floor. The other is of similar construction, but is on two levels to ease the pouring of milk into bulk tanks. Both have insulated walls.  
 The single and two-level masonry-block houses have similar floors, insulated walls and ceilings.  
 All four plans include removable partitions for use in installing or removing bulk tanks.  
 Plan 762 (single-level wood), plan 803 (single-level block), plan 779 (two-level wood), and plan 801 (two-level block) are available for 50 cents each from county agricultural agents or by writing Agricultural Engineering, Riley-Robb Hall, Cornell University, Ithaca, N. Y.

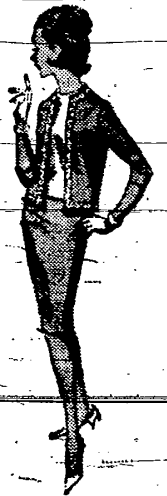
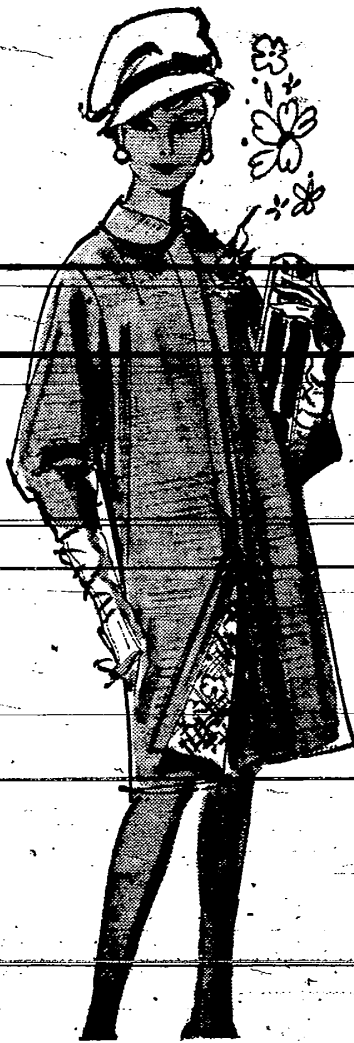
