Recipe for cookies is:
 Yield: 3 1/2 doz. cookies. Size of pan, cookie sheets. Temperature 375 Degrees F. Time 12 to 15 minutes.

1 1/2 cups sifted flour
 2 teasp. baking powder
 1/2 teasp. salt
 1/2 cup shortening
 1/2 cup peanut butter
 1/2 cup brown sugar
 1/2 cup granulated sugar
 1 egg
 1/2 teasp. vanilla

1. Have all ingredients at room temperature. Sift the flour before measuring. Sift together the flour, baking powder and salt. Mix together the shortening, peanut butter, brown sugar and granulated sugar. Beat until well blended. Add egg and vanilla. Beat well. Add the sifted dry ingredients to the creamed mixture and mix well. Form the dough into balls about 1 inch in diameter. Place 1 1/2" apart on a lightly greased cookie sheet. Press crosswise with a fork to flatten. Bake in a moderate oven. Remove cookies immediately from the pan and place on a cookie rack.

We made fudge candy which turned out fair.
