Recipe for Wacky Chocolate Cake
 1 1/2 cups flour
 1 cup sugar
 3 tablespoons cocoa
 1 teaspoon soda
 1/4 teaspoon salt
 6 tablespoons oil
 1 tablespoon vinegar
 1 teaspoon vanilla
 1 cup cold water

Sift all dry ingredients together in your pan; blend well. Then make three holes, a large one, a medium one and a small one. In the large one put oil. In medium one put vinegar; and in small one put vanilla. Then pour cup of cold water over it all. Blend with a fork. Make sure you mix corners good. Bake at 375 degrees F. until it springs back then cool and frost.
