**Rev. Paul R. Rust To Conduct Mission**

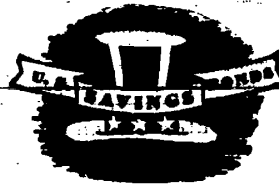

**Enough Trees For 234 Acres**

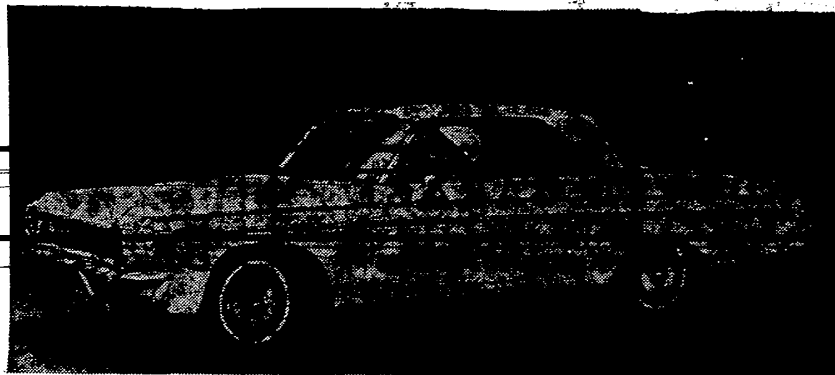

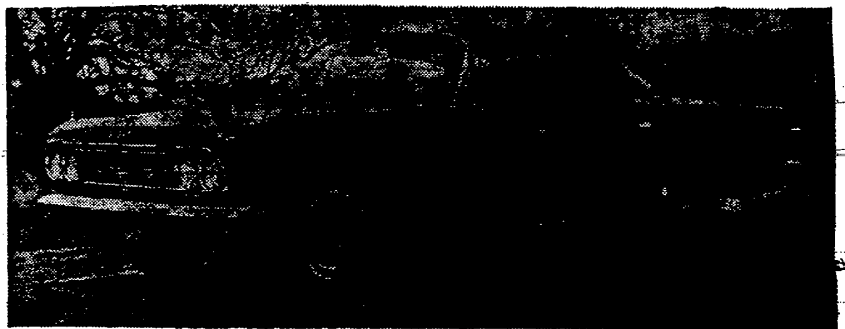
