Troop "C" NYARNG In Hornell To Hold Recruiting Drive

The National Guard Armory, at 100 Seneca St., Hornell, New York, has been designed as the Recruiting Center for a drive, starting Wednesday 22 July 1964, to enlist new members in Troop C 1st Squadron, 121 Cavalry, NYARNG.

Special recruiting personnel will be on duty there from 9:00 A. M. - 4:00 P. M., each day, except Saturday and Sunday during the recruiting drive which will continue through August 28, according to Capt. Harold N. Hand, Commanding Officer of Troop C.

There are approximately 20 vacancies in the National Guard. The recruiting drive is aimed at raising the unit to its authorized strength.

The National Guard wants physically and mentally qualified young men between the ages of 17 and 35. The Hornell unit has one drill period each week and climaxes its training year with two weeks at summer camp. National Guardsmen receive the pay and allowances of their corresponding ranks in the Regular Army, and average about one-sixth the annual pay of a regular. Capt. Hand emphasized that membership in the National Guard does not interfere with normal civilian pursuits. Members of the Guard between the ages of 17 and 35 are exempt from Selective Service so long as they remain active in the Guard for at least six years.

Parental consent is necessary to enlist young men aged 17 in the Guard. Some of the basic equipment the Hornell unit now has is one M-48 "Patton" Tank, armed with a 90 millimeter main gun, one Cal. 30 and one Cal. 50 machine gun, and weighs in at 50 tons; two M-41 Tanks with a 76 millimeter main gun, one Cal. 30 and one Cal. 50 machine gun; one personnel carrier which is a full track vehicle designed to carry 1 Infantry squad (11 men) fully equipped, armed with a Cal. 50 machine gun. The Hornell unit has most of the modern equipment to be found in a regular army unit.

The openings for tank drivers, gunners, jeep drivers, and mechanics are now being filled. Give it a try, it's a chance to learn while you earn.
