item in our budget—approximately 40 per cent of our expenditure. However, the directors and I strongly feel that this cost is an absolute necessity if we are to continue to bring to the Hornell area the quality of live symptonic music that we have in the past." The Hornell Symphony Associ-

The mornell Symphony Association is a non-profit, educational corporation, chartered by New York State, and is the legal sponsor of the orchestra. The Women's Learne is an integral sor of the orchestra. The Women's League is an integral part of the association and assists it in the support of the archestra. The league sponsors the Symphony Ball held in May. It also sponsored the art show, held recently during Hornell Shop-O-Rama.
