American Red Cross News

The Finance Committee for Allegany County Chapter of American Red Cross last week voted to eliminate the blood program from county Red Cross services, effective July 1, 1965 unless additional available

funds became available
that date.

Teacher T found fund requirements for 1965-66 which included the blood The total amounted to \$16,851.
The total amount raised for the 1964-65 campaign was \$14,717.
Since Home Service and Disas-

ter are mandatory services under the chapter's charter, the com-mittee was left no recourse but to mittee was left no recourse but to eliminate the chapter's most expensive program, the blood pregram. Budget requirements for the blood program for 1965-86 are \$4329. All other Red Cross programs added together would not provide the funds necessary to continue this service.

Committee advisors have informed both county hospitals and the county medical society of their decision and have assured them that funds are available to continue the program until July 1,

At present 42.4% of the chap-ter's local budget goes to the blood program. Increased costs are a result of the greater use of blood and the cost of new plastic blood and the cost of new plastic-bottles now in use. Also, in re-cent years the chapter has not reached its quots in fund drives and has been forced to use surplus funds to meet operating needs.

Because of the importance of the blood program, the Finance Committee was reluctant to eliminate the service. Blood itself, in Red Cross, is never charged for, but, if purchased, the 823 pint total used in county nospicals last year at \$50 per pint charged commercially benefit or Not gives a monetary benefit of \$41,150 to the community. Not included in this total is blood used hospitals by county residents.
