The dry conditions of the woods and pasture lands continue. From 75 to 100 acres was burned in a fire in the Town of West

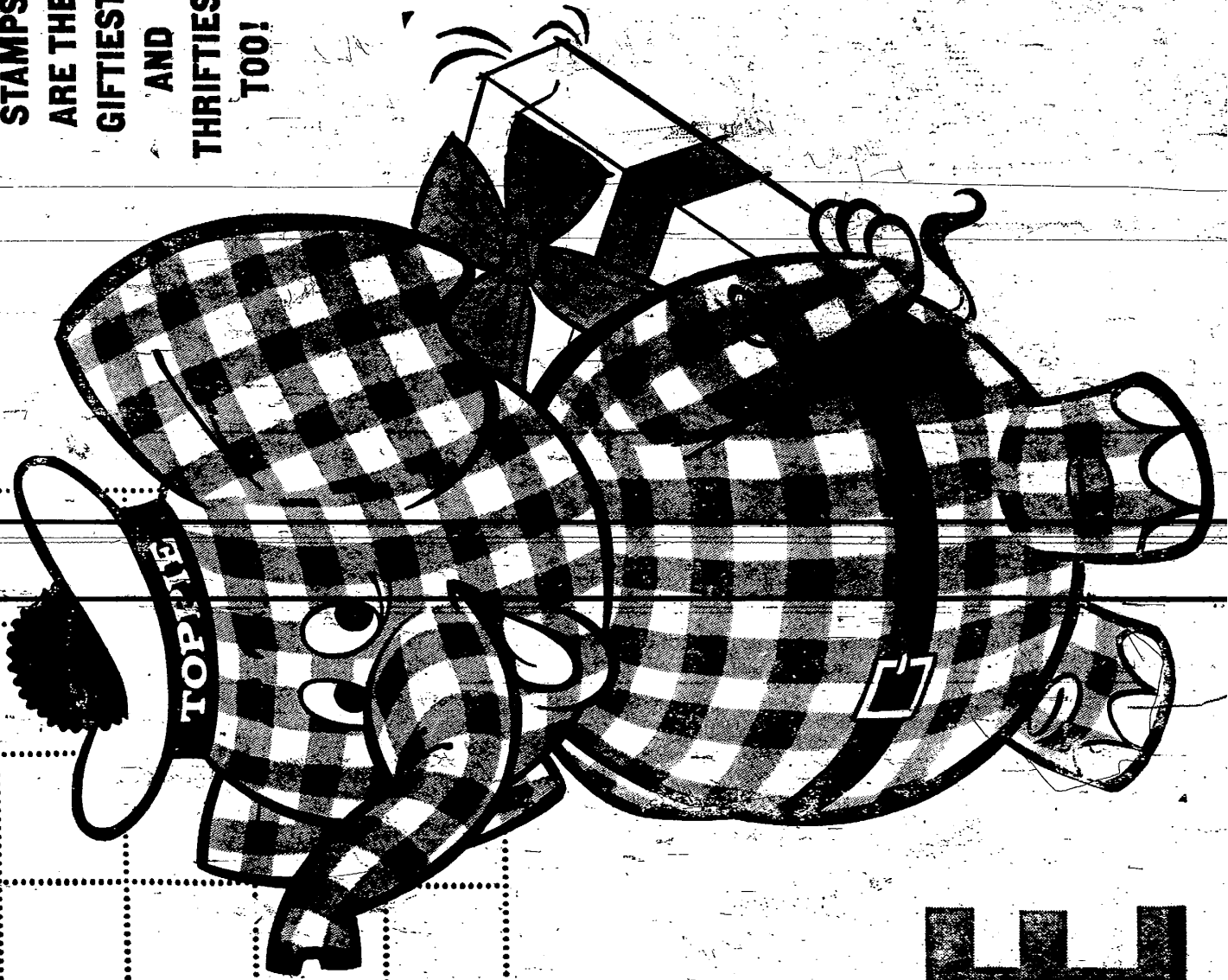
Union, near Rexville, and was under control about midnight, Tuesday, about nine hours after it was reported. Rexville firemen and conservation men battled it.
